Let's Go...Let's Grow! 4-H Enrollment 2017-2018

It's time to enroll in the 2017-2018 4-H year. The Texas 4-H and Youth Development Program will charge an annual participation fee 2016-17, the enrollment fee is \$20 from Sept 1 – October 31.

Enrollment fee after Nov. 1 is \$25.

The participant fee will ensure that the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service can continue to deliver the highest quality 4-H program in the world. A recent national research study shows:

Members reporting better grades, higher level of academic competence, and an elevated engagement in school.

Two times as many members likely to plan to go to college than non-members.

Members that reveal significantly lower drug, alcohol and cigarette use than their peers.

Members are three times more likely to actively contribute to their communities when compared with youth that do not participate in 4-H.

Clover kids (children in grades Kindergarten through 2nd grade) may also enroll. There is no enrollment fee for them.

Texas is proud to boast the largest 4-H membership enrollment, total 4-H participation, and the largest volunteer base

in the United States. The enrollment fee is an investment in the youth of Texas.

All Adult Leaders will need to enroll at this time also. There is a \$10.00 fee for the volunteer screening process which is a part of the Youth Protection Standards.

Food & Nutrition Project

It's time to kick off the Food & Nutrition Project! The Food and Nutrition Project is open to all 4-H members. Activities vary based on age and years of experience. Many of the projects involve practicing food preparation skills including food safety; learning to eat healthy, understanding the connection of a recipe to My Plate; and learning about nutrients in foods and the health benefits they provide for your body.

Food and Nutrition Project meetings will include:

- Nutrition Quiz Bowl Sessions

4-H FOOD SHOW:

The theme for the 2018 Food Show is "Fresh from the Farm". This theme will allow participants the opportunity to explore many aspects of fresh foods, physical activity, and the value of locally grown foods. Another aspect to consider is the simpler life of the farm and the importance of family and working together. In addition, 4-H members can discuss the growing season their dish is associated with: late spring and early summer, high summer, and early fall. As well as, discussing where the ingredients for their dish were grown, especially if purchased from a local producer or farmers market or possibly harvested from their own garden.

FOOD CHALLENGE CONTEST:

At the Food Challenge, teams of 3 to 5
4-H members receive a list of ingredients and have 40 minutes to create a dish. The teams then present their dish to judges are scored on preparation, serving size, food safety concerns, nutritional value and cost.

FOOD AND NUTRITION QUIZ BOWL:

A "Quiz Bowl" is a quiz game that tests teams of 3-4 on their knowledge of food and nutrition. Up against the clock, the 4-Hers buzz in to answer a question and earn points for correct answers. Teams advance in a tournament-system bracket to win the competition.

Lamb and Goat Validation will be held on **October 30, 2017** at the Springlake-Earth Ag Barn.

Heifer Validation:

Heifers will need to be validated this year for the Lamb County Jr. Livestock Show and all of the major shows next January-March.

Order tags (UIN Numbers) through the Springlake-Earth FFA website by Wednesday September 20, 2017. The site is: http://www.springlake-earthffa.org/Valida-tion/LambCountyValidation.aspx

The validation cost is \$20 per head. County only Heifers do not need UIN Numbers.

County only Heifers will also only show in the AOB class unless registration papers are provided.

Submit Original Heifer registration papers to Lamb County Extension Office by Wednesday, October 18, 2017. Please be prepared to leave them with us in the office a for a short while until we can complete the process.
